The I-15 South Design-Build Project area is from Tropicana Avenue to just south of Silverado Ranch Boulevard.

The project includes widening the freeway, the addition of collector-distributor roads, five re-designed interchanges, 26 new bridge sections, 35 retaining walls, 1.5 miles of sound walls, and the extension of the I-15 Express Lanes south to Silverado Ranch Boulevard.

PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING I-15 SOUTH DESIGN-BUILD PROJECT

The Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT), together with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), is working to improve the I-15 corridor from Tropicana Avenue to just south of Silverado Ranch Boulevard. The project's purpose is to relieve congestion and improve traffic flow in the I-15 corridor.

NDOT will conduct a public information meeting to provide an opportunity for you to share your thoughts and ideas about this project. The focus of this meeting will be on the items described in the box at the left as well as landscaping and aesthetics treatments and project schedule.
